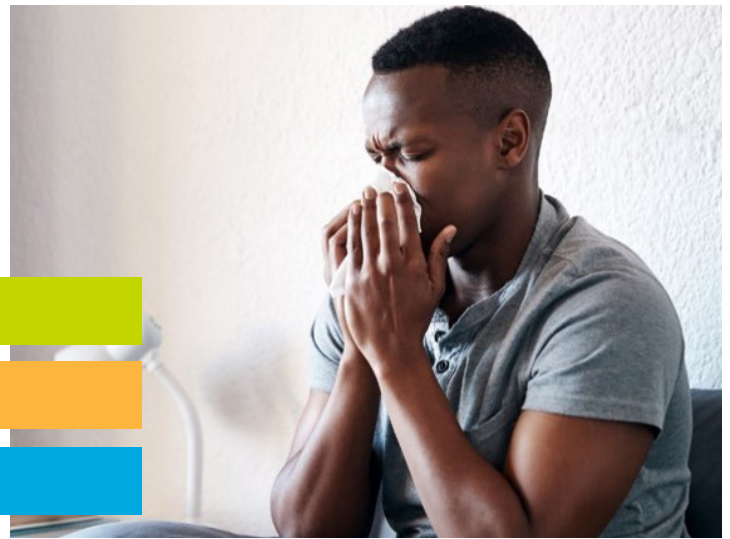


# OTC COVID-19 TESTS

Available at no cost to you



For many, regular COVID-19 testing at home has become a way of life. Your Cigna pharmacy plan can help you pay for these over-the-counter tests.

## Over-the-counter (OTC) test kits<sup>1</sup> are a quick and easy way to test for COVID-19.

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has authorized many rapid antigen tests, also known as “over-the-counter COVID tests,” for use. These tests provide results in minutes and can protect you and others by lowering the chances of spreading COVID-19.<sup>2</sup>

- ▶ Your Cigna pharmacy plan covers all FDA-authorized OTC COVID-19 test kits at **no cost-share (\$0)**.<sup>3</sup> These tests are for **personal use only**. They cannot be used for employment purposes, resale, or be reimbursed by another source.
- ▶ You can get an authorized test kit **at any in-network pharmacy** that has it available, or through **Express Scripts® Pharmacy**, our home delivery pharmacy.
- ▶ You **don't need a prescription** from your doctor.
- ▶ Your plan covers **up to eight tests per 30-days** (typically four test kit packages)<sup>4</sup> for each covered family member.

## Starting February 24<sup>th</sup>, get a COVID-19 test kit(s) at the pharmacy counter and pay \$0.<sup>3</sup>

### Using an in-network retail pharmacy:

- ▶ Bring the FDA-authorized test kit(s) to the **pharmacy counter** (not the regular checkout).
- ▶ Check out at the pharmacy counter and show your **Cigna ID card**. They'll process the test kit(s) under your pharmacy benefit. You'll pay \$0 out-of-pocket (tax may apply).

### Using Express Scripts® Pharmacy:

*Our home delivery pharmacy is available as part of your Cigna pharmacy benefit.*

- ▶ Log in to the **myCigna®** App or **myCigna.com®**. Click on the Prescriptions tab and select My Medications from the dropdown menu.
- ▶ In the section for COVID-19 test kits, click on the “Order from Express Scripts Pharmacy” button.
- ▶ Once you're on Express Scripts' website, look for the *Quick links* section in the Dashboard. Then click on “Order At-Home COVID-19 Tests.”
- ▶ After you place your order, Express Scripts® Pharmacy will ship the test kits directly to you.

If you aren't able to buy a COVID-19 test kit(s) at the pharmacy counter (or you pay for it out-of-pocket), you can ask your Cigna pharmacy plan to refund you up to \$12 per test. Simply go to [Cigna.com/coronavirus](https://www.cigna.com/coronavirus), or log into the **myCigna** App or [myCigna.com](https://www.myCigna.com), to get started. You'll need to complete a claims form and provide your receipt.<sup>6</sup> You can use the instructions on the form or on your Cigna ID card to send in your claim.

## Vaccines are the best way to protect yourself and others against COVID-19.<sup>7</sup>

All currently approved or authorized COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective, and lower your risk of severe illness.<sup>8</sup> The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that everyone **ages five years and older get the COVID-19 vaccine** and everyone ages 16 years and older get booster shots (when eligible).<sup>8</sup>

It is anticipated this government-required coverage will remain in effect through the end of the Public Health Emergency. 4. **This limit applies to the actual number of tests - not test kits - you buy** (tests may be packaged individually or with multiple tests in one kit). This limit doesn't include any tests ordered or administered by your doctor. 5. Standard shipping costs are included as part of your prescription plan. 6. To be reimbursed, you'll need to send in the completed and signed Pharmacy Claim Form and your receipt showing the date you bought the test(s) and how much you paid. 7. Health benefit plans vary, but in general to be eligible for coverage a drug must be approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), prescribed by a health care professional, purchased from a licensed pharmacy and medically necessary. If your plan provides coverage for certain prescription drugs with no cost-share, you may be required to use an in-network pharmacy to fill the prescription. If you use a pharmacy that does not participate in your plan's network, your prescription may not be covered, or reimbursement may be limited by your plan's copayment, coinsurance or deductible requirements. Certain features described in this document may not be applicable to your specific health plan, and plan features may vary by location and plan type. Refer to your plan documents for costs and complete details of your plan's prescription drug coverage.

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
