Group Critical Illness Health Screening Benefit

\$50 payable once per calendar year for each covered insured who has a qualifying health screening test performed

If you and your spouse or domestic partner are covered by the Critical Illness plan, you may be eligible to file a claim for one of the covered routine tests performed each year. (Dependent children are not covered.)

The tests include the following:

- COVID-19 screening
- Stress test on a bicycle or treadmill
- Fasting blood glucose test, blood tests for triglycerides or serum cholesterol test to LDL
- Bone marrow testing
- Breast ultrasound
- CA 15-3 (blood test for breast cancer)
- CA 125 (blood test for ovarian cancer)
- CEA (blood test for colon cancer)
- Chest X-Ray
- Colonoscopy
- Flexible sigmoidoscopy
- Hemocult stool analysis
- Mammography
- Pap Smear
- PSA (blood test for prostate cancer)
- Serum protein electrophoresis (blood test for myeloma)
- Thermograph
- HIV test performed via nucleic acid test (NAT)
- HPV test performed via Pap smear



Group Accident Wellness Benefit

\$50 payable once per calendar year for each covered insured who has a qualifying wellness test performed

This benefit is payable for you and your covered family members once per calendar year for health screening tests performed as the result of preventive care, including tests and diagnostic procedures ordered in connection with routine examinations. This benefit is payable for each insured.

The tests include the following:

- COVID-19 screening
- Annual physical exam
- Flexible sigmoidoscopy
- Mammogram
- PSA test
- Pap smear
- Ultrasound
- Eye examination
- Blood screening
- Immunization
